Job Purpose: The Public Health Nurse Manager's main purpose is for the concern of the health of Sonoma County Indian Health Project's Native Community including individuals and family members. This position has a strong emphasis on health promotion, outreach, illness prevention and health maintenance. Public Health Nursing activities include, but are not limited to, systematic analysis of health data, care plan development, health education and advocacy, coalition building, and collaborating with community partners to promote the health of the Native population. This position is responsible for the supervision and direction of their support team (i.e. Community Health Representatives.)

Qualifications:

- Graduate of an accredited school of Nursing with a Bachelor's Degree in Nursing.
- Certificate in Community Health Nursing Preferred.
- Current unrestricted license to practice as a PHN/Registered Nurse in the state of California.
- Two (2) to Three (3) years of clinical experience in a health care setting.
- Possess current CPR/BLS certification.
- Able to communicate effectively with people at all levels and from various backgrounds.
- Excellent interpersonal, verbal, written and presentation skills.
- Prior work history in Indian Health Services (IHS), Tribal/Urban clinics, a plus.
- Hold a current California Drivers License and be insurable.
- Must pass a pre-employment drug screen, physical and background investigation

Special Qualifications: Must be sensitive to the needs of the Native American Community, which includes their culture, traditions and background.
